Latino/Hispanic Community

There are 42.7 million people in the United States who describe themselves as Hispanic or Latino. Persons of Hispanic or Latino origin comprise 15.4 percent of the total United States population and 4.1 percent of Minnesota's population. Latino families have been living in Minnesota for generations; the first record of Latino families can be traced back to 1860.

Latino families and children represent the fastest growing population in the child welfare system. According to the 2007 Child Welfare Report, Latino or Hispanic children comprise 8.4 percent of the children in out-of-home placement. In 2007 Latino children had the fourth highest reentry rate (19.4 percent), after Asians (24.1 percent), African-Americans (20.7 percent), and American Indians (19.8%).
