
OPEN SYSTEMS MODEL



Successful implementation of the Open Systems Model requires supervisors to develop and carry out the following tasks:

- A positive vision of the future (what the unit aspires to become).
- Unit critical outcomes
- Measures of internal unit performance (success)
- Measures of external effectiveness with clients and in collaborating with other units (accountability).
- Assessment of worker performance
- Fostering the worker's ability to self-assess and gain proficiency through experience,
- Promoting worker adherence to social work values,
- Promoting unit use of culturally competent strategies and skills.
